






Importance of Air Transport

- □ Connects the world's cities with over 36,000 routes
- □ Flies 48 million tonnes of freight annually worth \$5.3 trillion (35% of world trade)
- □ Generates a total of 56.6 million jobs globally with direct employment of over 8.4 million
- □ Economic footprint (direct, indirect, induced and tourism catalytic) estimated at \$2.2 trillion, equivalent to 3.5% of world GDP



Seamless Asian Skies Vision

A safe, uniform, and sustainable Asia Pacific aviation infrastructure for 2020 and beyond

- Harmonized, Interoperable, regional network of air navigation services
- Political Leadership & Mandate required





Seamless Asian Skies Strategy

- ICAO plays a vital role
 - → Future concepts
 - Regulation and guidelines
 - But States responsible for implementation.





Seamless ATM Planning

- → The Global Air Navigation Plan
- → The Global Aviation Safety Plan
- Asia Pacific Regional Air Navigation Plan for Seamless ATM
 - → The Aviation System Block upgrades



Plan for seamless ATM

- → Seamless NOT Single
