

## **ENRI Employment Information for International Researchers**

ENRI is currently looking for researchers in the following area:

### **Study on Air Traffic Management**

This area of study includes research and development regarding future air traffic operations, such as airspace design, airspace management, trajectory management. These studies aim for the improvement of safety and efficiency of the air traffic that also includes next generation air mobility.

### **Study on Aeronautical Communication, Navigation, and Surveillance**

This area of study includes research and development regarding future Air Traffic Control System, such as Digital Information Communication System for aircraft, Satellite Navigation System, ATC Radar, to realize safer and more efficient flight operations of current civil aircraft and next generation air mobility, utilizing electronic information communication technology.

Applicants are expected to have a Master's or anticipated Master's degree or higher in Science and/or Engineering, or equivalent capability in the areas of System Engineering, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Information and Communication Engineering, Mathematics, Physics, Aerospace Engineering, and/or Transportation Engineering.

The term of appointment will be determined on a contract basis, and will initially be up to three years. Longer-term appointment may be provided after assessment.

The working conditions will be as follows:

- 2) Salary: Three-year contract 383,960 yen/month for Ph.D. degree holders

259,260 yen/month for Master's degree holders
- 4) Working hours: *Additionally, commuting fees, allowances for overtime, and terminal allowances will be paid.*  
7 hours and 45 minutes/day, 5 days a week, with flexible hours
- 5) Holidays: Weekends, public holidays, year-end and new-year holidays, and paid-holidays
- 6) Social insurance: Health insurance supported by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, workers' accident compensation insurance, and unemployment insurance
- 7) Benefits: A housing allowance is paid under our regulations. However, it will not be paid in the case of employees with a three-year contract.
- 8) Official Language: Japanese

Applications must include:

- 1) A research plan that identifies the applicant's future work at ENRI,
- 2) A complete Curriculum Vitae (CV), including any awards and/or qualifications that demonstrate the applicant's competence, and contact details such as a telephone number and/or an e-mail address,
- 3) A list of publications and copies of major academic papers (up to 5 papers),

Please note that as part of the selection process, applicants may be asked to visit ENRI for interview and to give a presentation about their research plan. On-line interview will be acceptable instead of face-to-face interview, on request.
